Habitat for Humanity of Greater Los Angeles (Habitat LA) is seeking a qualified candidate to play an important role in deepening our affiliate's community impact through Neighborhood Revitalization and Community Engagement programs helping us to engage 5,000 community members. Through outreach, the member will support the NRI's objective of partnering with local organizations and residents, participating in neighborhood collaborative meetings, developing and implementing a resident leadership development program, and coordinating community projects to address neighborhood needs. The member will be instrumental in maintaining and developing relationships with networks and potential partners, develop and implement engagement programs and outreach activities focused on youth and veterans/military communities. Habitat for Humanity of Greater Los Angeles has been an active affiliate of Habitat for Humanity International for more than 20 years. By providing affordable housing, home repairs, skilled construction training, financial education, and volunteer opportunities the organization has transformed millions of lives, helped stabilize communities and fostered economic vitality in the region. On average, the affiliate builds and renovates 100 homes in the Los Angeles region, ranking it among the largest affiliates nationwide.

SUMMARY OF ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Develop and implement a resident leadership program targeted toward the affiliate's NR areas.
- Manage one community project to address neighborhood needs as identified by the NR coalition or residents.
- Develop and implement two new and sustainable projects will be led by VISTA member that will increase capacity at the affiliate engaging Veteran/Military community and youth
- \$10,000 cash and in-kind resources will be raised utilizing systems and opportunities identified by VISTA member (includes resources raised for home building efforts, as well as ReStores, youth programs Nickels for Nails, ASBW and Youth United)
- Engage up to 5,000 individuals on projects related to this position. (Stakeholders, volunteers, youth, veteran/military, community members, staff, etc.)
- Develop and implement a Veteran/Military engagement plan that will result in 30 Veteran applicants identified for home repair and/or homeownership programs.
- The Veterans Advisory Council will grow to an active group of 12 individuals whose primary goal is outreach.
- Establish/maintain ten stakeholder partnerships focused on Veteran/Military or Youth programs
