Habitat for Humanity of Greater Los Angeles (Habitat LA) is seeking a qualified candidate to play an important role in providing outreach services in our expanded service area to promote our disaster response, home repair and home ownership programs, as well as help take applications from those applying for service and volunteering to assist with home repairs. In addition and emphasis will be placed on outreach for youth programs and enrolling new campuses as campus chapters in the expanded area. Habitat for Humanity of Greater Los Angeles has been an active affiliate of Habitat for Humanity International for more than 20 years. By providing affordable housing, home repairs, skilled construction training, financial education, and volunteer opportunities the organization has transformed millions of lives, helped stabilize communities and fostered economic vitality in the region. On average, the affiliate builds and renovates 100 homes in the Los Angeles region, ranking it among the largest affiliates nationwide.

SUMMARY OF ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Build relationships and partner with residents, local agencies, elected officials, and community stakeholders. These partnerships will
 help to identify areas where host site housing and community development solutions can intersect with the community's identified
 aspirations.
- Identify community improvement projects and plan and execute projects for successful completion (ex. Community clean ups, community garden, ABWK projects, etc.)
- Engage volunteers from the local community to support the local projects planned.
- Coordinate and document the implementation of host site's housing and community development solutions in partnership with the community.
- Monitor and evaluate the outcomes of the plan through our survey tool, Success Measures.
- Identify and reach out to high school and college campuses that have no Habitat affiliation to explain programs and assist with
 establishing new relationships.
- Do research to determine housing programs funded by local governments providing information for contact to senior staff for negotiation of program administration.
- Assist with establishing meetings and documenting agreements and implementations of new programs.
