If you live in a mobile or manufactured home within the City of Lancaster limits, and use this home as your primary residence, Habitat LA may be able to assist you with repairs. Just scan below to fill out the application, then provide the requisite ownership and income documents, and a site assessment will be scheduled to confirm the need for repairs. This loan is available to low-income residents of Lancaster. At Habitat LA, we believe that everyone deserves a decent place to live. **Inquire today!**



Loan Details

- Max loan: \$150,000
- 0% interest, deferred payment
- Forgivable (must have non-permanent foundation and be in a mobile home park):
 - Forgiven 10% annually starting at 11th year
 - Fully forgiven after 20 years of occupancy

Who Can Apply

- Own and live in a mobile/manufactured home within City of Lancaster limits
- Occupy the home as a primary residence
- Low-income residents (≤80% AMI), see table below
- Other requirements as noted in screening form linked below

Application Process:

- 1. Do initial screening and later submit full application
- 2. Verify income
- 3. Get site assessment and submit contractor estimates
