Welcome from our President and Co-Chairs

On behalf of Habitat for Humanity of Greater Los Angeles (Habitat LA), we welcome you to an evening of celebration and gratitude. We are thrilled to be together live and in person to celebrate our incredible partners who have helped us reach some extraordinary goals during unprecedented times.

Last year, we began construction on our 1,001st home, which is a huge achievement in one of the toughest housing markets in the nation. We completed the construction of nine new affordable homes, all of which have been purchased by low-income, first-time homeowners – and offered homeownership counseling opportunities so that many more can start their journey to homeownership. Our Home Preservation team repaired homes for 65 low-income households, many of whom are seniors, veterans, or individuals with disabilities. We provided more than 3,000 people with supplies and financial assistance through our COVID-19 relief efforts, and we worked hand-in-hand with Long Beach residents to envision a revitalized, more cohesive Washington neighborhood.

As you'll see tonight, Habitat LA's ability to make such a deep impact is dependent on our partnerships with corporations, foundations, government officials, religious and spiritual communities, and the thousands of individuals who not only believe in our mission but lend a hand in its success.

Together, we celebrate and highlight three of these partners – Clark Construction, City National Bank, and Chandra Wilson – for contributing their time, talent, and resources to transform the landscape of greater Los Angeles. Habitat LA's mission is simple: We bring people together to build homes, community, and hope. The contributions you have made toward this mission help our partners achieve their dreams.

For many, they will be the first in their family to be a homeowner, enabling them to transform their long-term economic path. For others, they may finally have a safe or stable place to call home, or a place where they can gather during the holidays, or where their children have enough space to study. Thank you for being an important partner of Habitat LA, and for helping us transform houses to homes and neighborhoods to communities.
