Beloved events like Poker Night, Art House, and Trivia Night have become signature gatherings, creating both joy and impact.

Cindy's commitment knows no boundaries. She has traveled to Nicaragua and Argentina to support Habitat's global initiatives, building homes alongside families and inspiring others to take part in Habitat's life-changing work. Her dedication extends beyond Habitat, as she has also hosted exchange students from Italy and India and raised two service dogs for Canine Companions.

A natural leader and community builder, Cindy has graciously opened both her home and family business, Los Angeles Ale Works, to host gatherings that celebrate giving and strengthen connections. As a partner at Los Angeles Ale Works, she blends her love for business innovation with her passion for philanthropy, continuing to inspire others to build stronger, more connected communities.

As a legendary LA Lakers NBA champion and coach, Byron Scott values teamwork—a principle he and CeCe have carried into their partnership with Habitat LA. The couple have generously contributed their time, resources, and influence to advancing Habitat LA's mission. From hands-on volunteering at Power Women Power Tools® and Entertainment Industry Build to championing affordable housing and educational initiatives, their impact throughout greater Los Angeles and Long Beach has been profound.



Byron's illustrious career spans three NBA championships with the Lakers during the "Showtime" era, a stint as NBA Head Coach of the Year, and his current role as a Spectrum SportsNet commentator. Beyond basketball, he is a best-selling author, entrepreneur, and philanthropist, co-founding ventures like Ethel's Baking Company and Comisario Tequila. His nonprofit, the Byron Scott Challenge for Children, has raised over \$15 million for children's charities. He is an advocate for several charities and for Sickle Cell Disease.

As a seasoned registered nurse with 27 years of experience, Cece's background with the LA County Medical Center was in the operating room, particularly in trauma as a certified operating room nurse. Cece founded several successful medical spas, including the acclaimed Rejuvenation Center in Manhattan Beach and her current medspa in Los Angeles called Contour Medical Spa.

Together, the Scotts exemplify leadership, generosity, and innovation. Their dedication to Habitat LA and other philanthropic efforts continues to uplift communities and inspire others to build a brighter future.

Featured Entertainment Robin Thicke

Robin Thicke is a five-time GRAMMY® Award nominee, diamond-selling artist, actor, entrepreneur, and philanthropist. Born in Los Angeles, he taught himself to play piano at 12 and was writing and producing for top R&B artists by 16. At 21, he had already contributed to more than 20 gold and platinum albums, working with icons like Michael Jackson, Marc Anthony, Pink, Christina Aguilera, Usher, and Jennifer Hudson. A year later, he signed with Jimmy Iovine and Interscope Records.



Thicke made his mark as a solo artist with his critically acclaimed 2003 debut, *A Beautiful World*, followed by a string of gold and platinum-selling albums. His 2013 album *Blurred Lines* debuted at No. 1 on the Billboard 200, driven by its record-breaking title track featuring T.I. and Pharrell. The song held the No. 1 spot on the Billboard Hot 100 for 12 consecutive weeks, making history as the first song to top five radio charts simultaneously (Top 40, Rhythm, Urban, Hot AC & Urban AC). The album earned four GRAMMY nominations and cemented Thicke as a global superstar.

In 2021, Thicke returned with *On Earth, and in Heaven*, his first studio album in six years, featuring the Billboard Adult R&B No. 1 hit "Look Easy" and the Pharrell-assisted "Take Me Higher," which became the ESPN/ABC Primetime song for the NBA season.

Beyond music, Thicke is a panelist on FOX's hit show *The Masked Singer*, alongside Ken Jeong, Jenny McCarthy Wahlberg, and Nicole Scherzinger. The show, now in its 13th season, continues to be a ratings success.

Thicke's latest release, "Brown Liquor" featuring Yo Gotti, showcases his signature smooth R&B sound.

This year, Thicke will bring his dynamic energy to the stage as the featured entertainment at the 2025 Los Angeles Builders Ball, an evening dedicated to raising funds and awareness for Habitat for Humanity of Greater Los Angeles' mission of building homes and transforming communities.



Tonight's Host Pat Prescott

Pat Prescott is a radio veteran whose career started at WYLD FM in New Orleans. She held various positions in her 23-year run in New York at WRVR, WBLS, WLIB and CD 101.9. For 21 years, Pat was a host for the morning show on 94.7 The Wave in Los Angeles, where she co-hosted for 6 years with saxophonist Dave Koz and for 4 years with singer-songwriter Brian McKnight. She can currently be heard as host of *Favorite Things With Pat Prescott* on legendary NPR jazz station WBGO, serving the New York tri-state area.
