## ACCEPTED MATERIALS:

**Appliances:** Clean and in working condition, less than 8 years old.

**Brick and Block:** Neatly stacked and palletized, minimum quantities for block: 25; no broken pieces.

**Cabinets:** Complete and modular, with all doors and drawers; slight damage okay.

**Doors:** Interior and exterior; no broken glass or damaged wood; prefer hardware removed and bagged separately; no hollow flat-slab doors.

**Electrical:** Fixtures, parts, and supplies; slight damage okay.

**Exercise Equipment:** In good working condition, 5 years or newer.

**Furniture:** Home and antique; no worn, stained, or ripped upholstery; overall good condition.

**Hardware:** Knobs, hinges, locks, nails, screws, nuts, bolts and fasteners, prefer separated by type/style.

**Household Items:** Dishes, silverware, frames, decorative items, and home decor pieces.

**Lumber:** Dimensional: 6 ft. or longer; sheets: 1/2 sheet or larger; free of rot, nails, and screws; no scraps.

**Tiles & Mosaics:** Job lot quantities (300 square ft. minimum); uncut full pieces; ready-to-install.

**Windows:** Vinyl or wood, new construction, and retro-fits with dual pane glass. No aluminum-framed, single pane, broken glass, or damaged wood frames.
