Home Repairs for Veterans

Are you a veteran in need of home repairs? Habitat for Humanity of Greater Los Angeles (Habitat LA) provides repairs and non-cosmetic improvements to low-income veteran households to help alleviate health and safety issues in and around their home. Veteran households include households with a veteran homeowner or a caregiver to a veteran household member. Homeowners pay for repair services through an affordable repayment plan.

2019 Income Eligibility Requirements

Eligibility Requirements*:

- Must own a home within the Habitat LA service area.
- Home must be owner occupied and serve as primary residence of owner(s) and veteran(s).
- Veterans must demonstrate proof of veteran status and honorable discharge.
- Home must be a single-family residence, condominium/townhome or mobile home.
- Multi-family residences (apartments, duplexes, etc.) are not eligible.
- Household income must be below current maximum income limits. (see chart below)
- Must agree to an affordable one-time payment or zero-interest forgivable loan.
- Must be willing to partner with Habitat LA by investing a minimum of 24 sweat equity volunteer hours.
- Homeowners must be a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Legal Resident.
- Additional requirements may apply.
